- The main entrance is open from 6 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- At night, between the hours of 5 p.m. to 6 a.m., please call the Birth Center at (949) 365-2141 to tell them you are have arrived at the Tower 1 entrance. A caregiver will promptly come to let you in. If your call is not quickly answered, please call (949) 365-2151.
- If your delivery is imminent, you have unusual bleeding or you have a medical concern unrelated to your pregnancy – you must go to the Emergency Department immediately.

We recognize that these new processes are inconvenient and we apologize, but given the COVID-19 pandemic we have implemented these precaution for your safety, as well as the safety of your child and family.
